 \succ Scalability: Digitalization through ICT tools ensures that programs can scale and adapt to changing demands and requirements without compromising performance or efficiency.




Flowchart indicating NIALS Processes in Digitalization





PROPOSED 2024 ENGAGEMENT ON SOCIAL MEDIA HANDLE 2024


