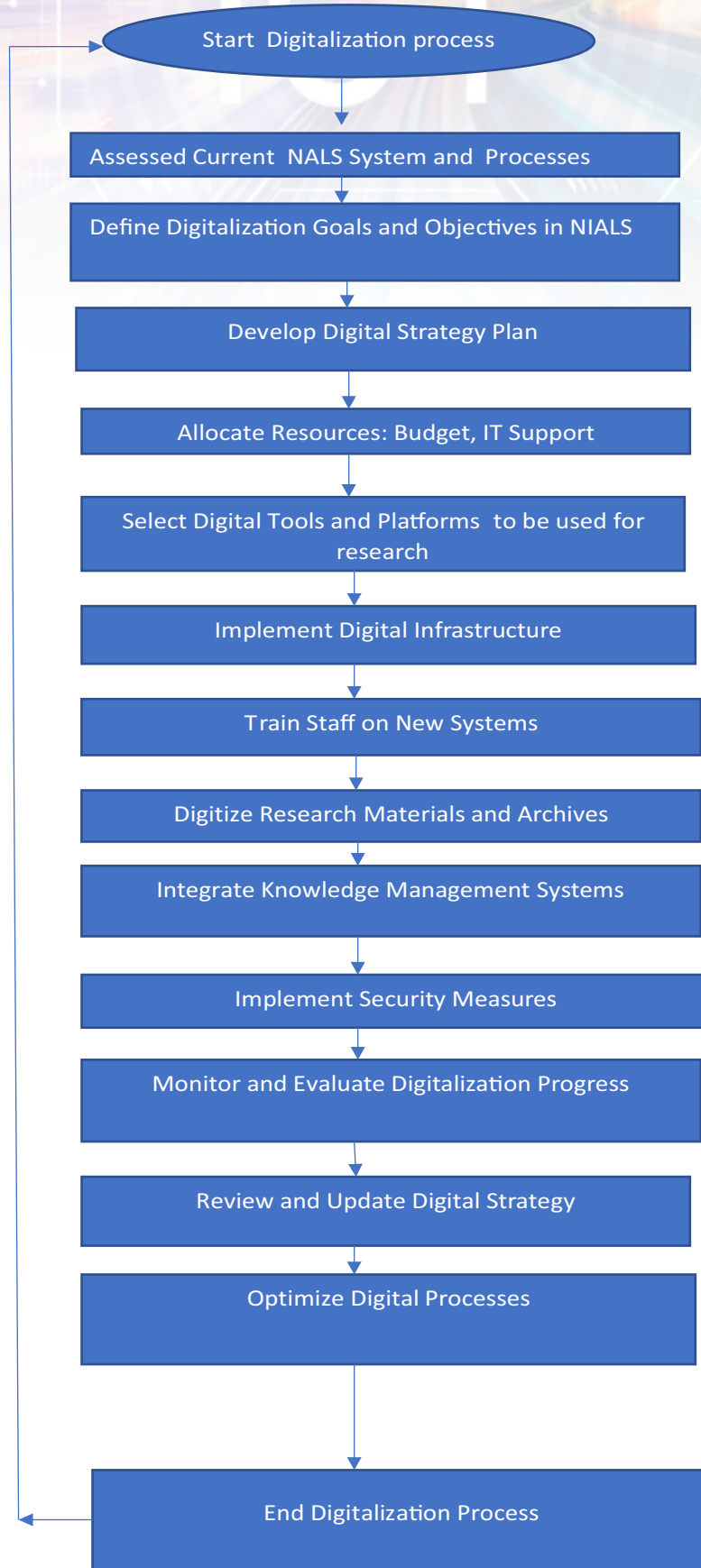

OBJECTIVES OF ICT TOOLS IN DIGITALIZATION OF NIALS PROGRAMMES

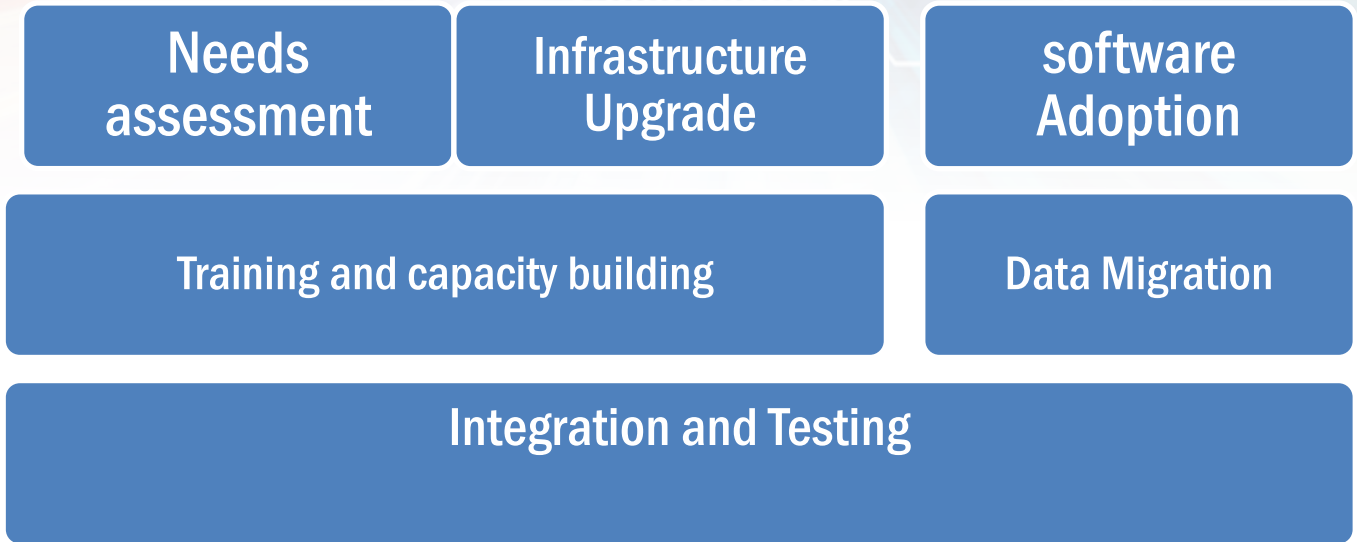

- **Scalability:** Digitalization through ICT tools ensures that programs can scale and adapt to changing demands and requirements without compromising performance or efficiency.

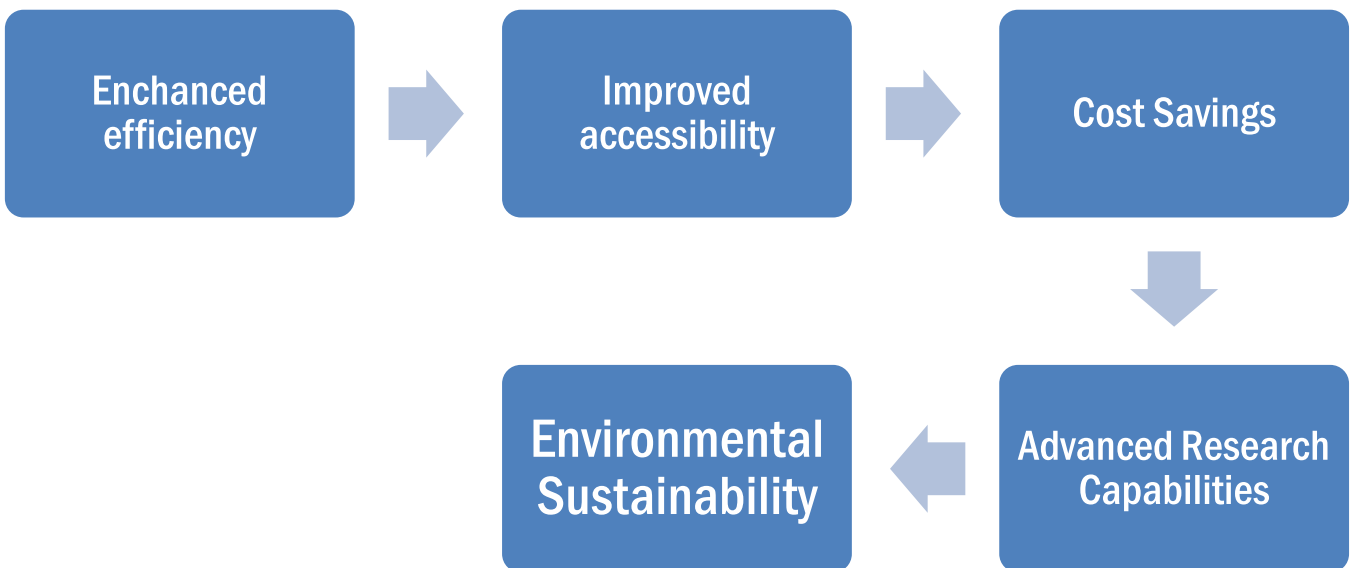
Flowchart indicating NIALS Processes in Digitalization

It is the innovative ways/processes of leveraging digitisation to improve business. The use of digital technologies and data to change and evolve.

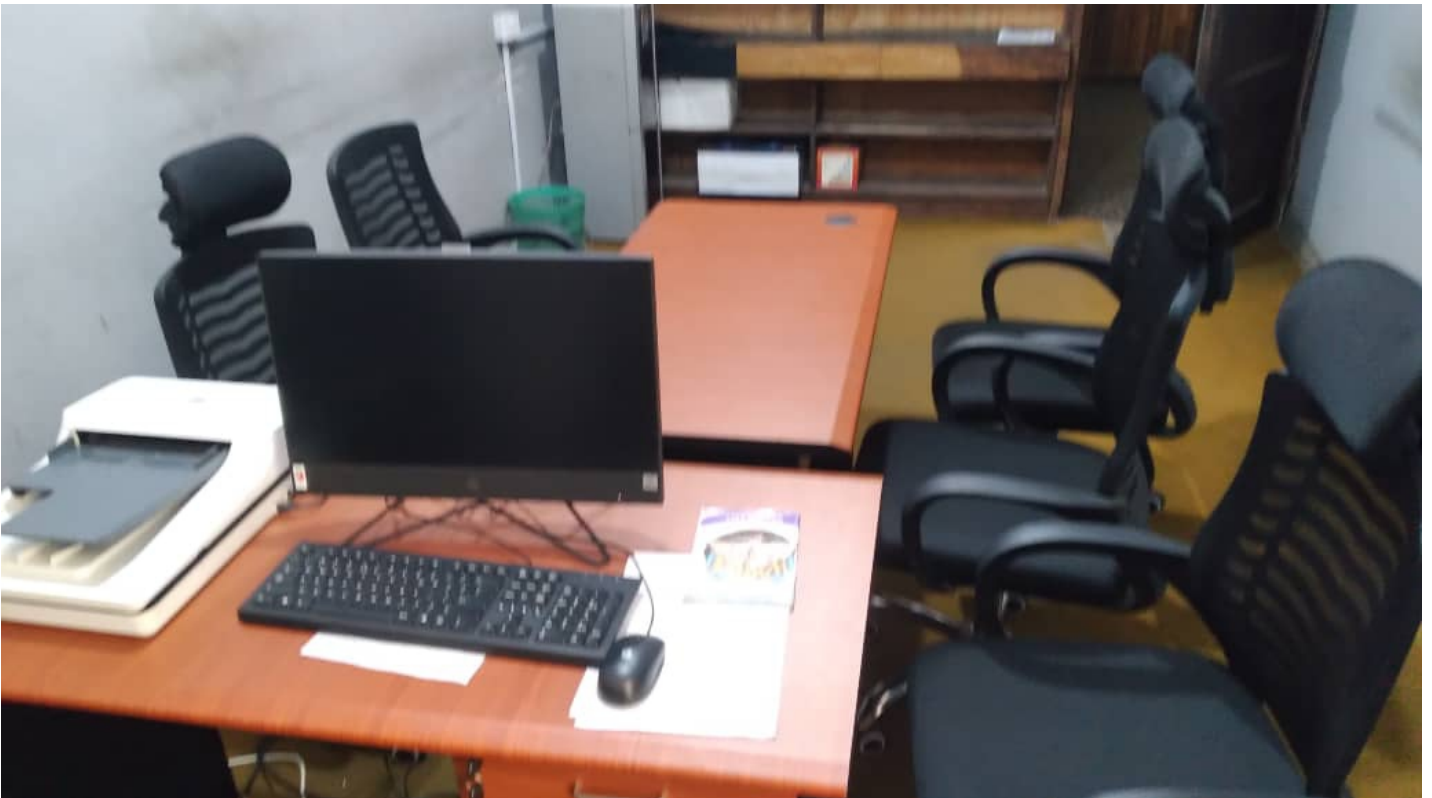

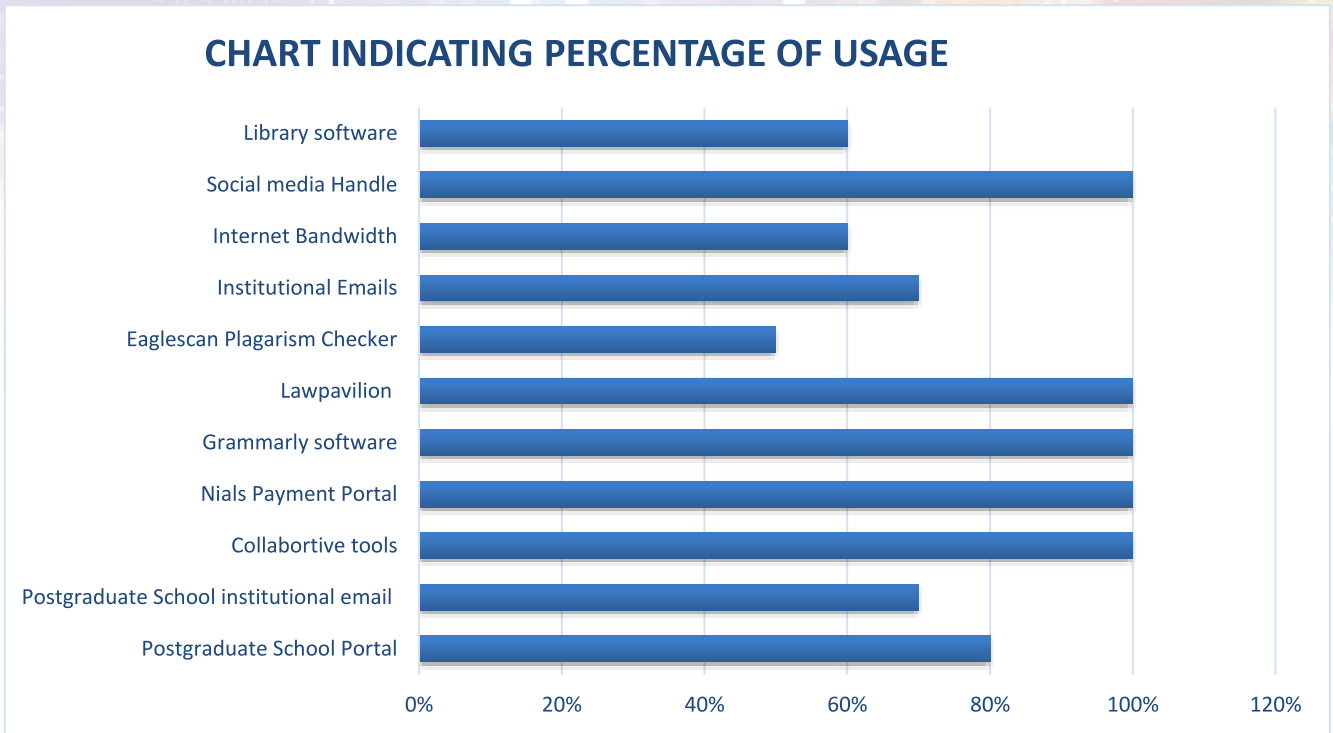

PROPOSED 2024 ENGAGEMENT ON SOCIAL MEDIA HANDLE 2024

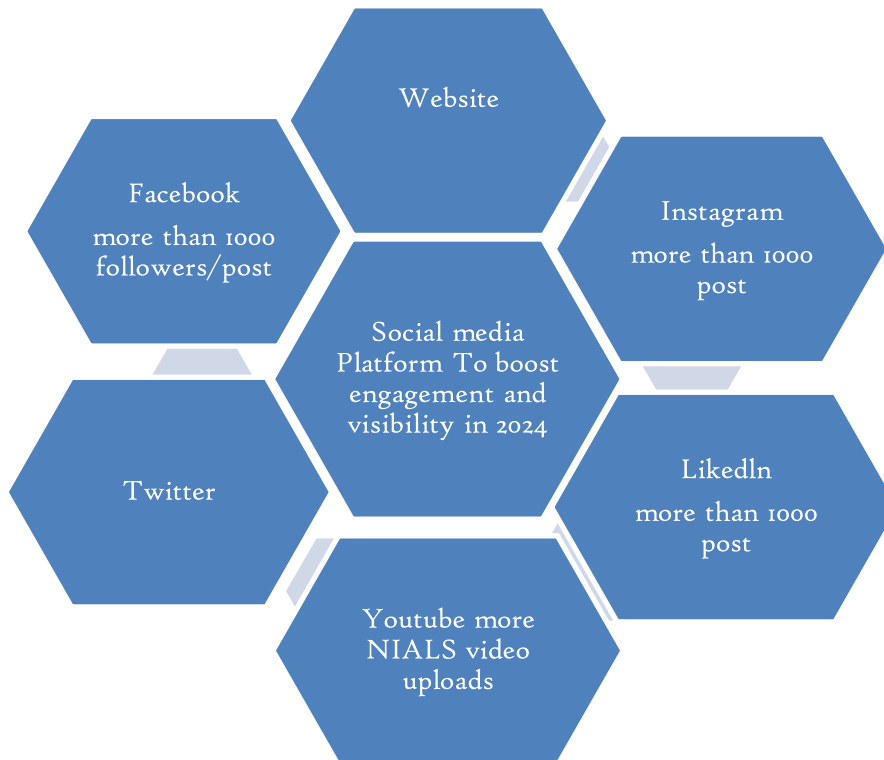
